- Please circle the dates & classes you plan to enter. A separate form must be used for each Horse & Rider combination.
- **Day of Show Registration** but pre-registration is encouraged. Mail completed form to Wayne County CCE.
- Show office opens at 7:00 am each day with classes to begin promptly at 8:00 am.
- **Entry Fee: \$4.00 per class or \$25.00/day per horse/rider combo.**
- Stabling is \$5.00. A \$5.00 surcharge will be added if stall is not cleaned. Stalls are on a first-come-first-served basis.
- Shows are open to all enrolled New York State 4-H members.
- Ages as of Jan 1: **Clover Buds:** 5 - 7 **Novice:** first year, 8 - over **Juniors:** 8 - under 14 **Seniors:** 14 – over.
- Exhibitor must be approved at the riding level entered and present proof of rider evaluation from the county where enrolled.
- Approved proper equestrian footwear with a distinguishable heel and an approved helmet must be worn at all times that a rider is mounted on an equine, sitting in a cart or handling an equine while on the fairgrounds.
- All riders must check in at the horse Show Office for helmet & boot inspection, to complete required entry forms, and to verify exhibitor number before entering the ring. Must bring current Negative Coggins & current Proof of Rabies Vaccination.
- Numbers must be displayed at all times when mounted or handling an equine, and turned in at the end of each show.
- NYS 4-H Horse Show Rules apply. Available at <http://www.ansci.cornell.edu/4H/horses/rulebook/index.html> or the Show Office.
- No coaching from the ringside. Unmanageable and/or unsound equines will be dismissed from the ring or the grounds.
- Exhibitors and/or parents may be excused from the class and/or the remainder of the show for unsportsmanlike conduct.
- No parent, coach, visitor or exhibitor may approach, question or direct public comment to or about the judge. Any protests must be handled through the Show Office before the next class.
- Training aids are allowed during schooling and at any time in the warm-up area. Improper use will be considered inhumane.
- Horses outside the show ring shall be ridden at a walk, except in the designated warm-up area.
- Trail class will open after showmanship and close before Hunter Under Saddle (English Division) or Reining (Western Division).
- Team games may be split into Novice, Junior, & Senior Divisions if there are enough entries.
- Patterns for trail and jumping classes will be posted at the Show Office at least one hour prior to the class.
- All fitting, grooming, care and schooling of a project animal is to be done by a 4-H Member.
- Scratches must be reported to the Horse Show Office at least one class prior for refund.
- All required tack changes must be reported to the Horse Show Office no later than one class prior to the needed change. The tack change will be announced and 3 minutes allowed.
- First through Sixth place ribbons in each class. High Point and Reserve Rosettes in each division.
- Breakfast, Lunch, & Dinner available on the grounds. Proceeds benefit the Wayne County 4-H Horse Program.
