Rules and Regulations:

- All riders must wear ASTM/SEI approved helmet.
- Helmet and number required when mounted.
- Walk/Trot/Jog Riders 8 Years Old and Up
- Youth Riders 9-19 Years Old
- Open Riders Minimum 8 Years Old
- Youth can cross enter into open classes.
- Walk/Trot cannot cross enter
- Riders competing in the crossrails class cannot cross enter into other jumping sections
- Informal attire (breeches and tall boots/western chaps required).
- Participants must sign acknowledgment of risk/release form.
- Current Negative Coggins and proof of Rabies Vaccine required to unload.
- No Stallions.
- Classes may be split or combined at judge's discretion.
- Register day of show or pre-register.
- All complaints will be directed to show management.
- Judges decisions are final.
- Kickers must have red ribbon in tail.
- USHJA biting rules will be in effect.
- No coaching from rails while classes are running.
- Must be registered at least three classes BEFORE the class you are registering for.
- Management reserves right to deny participation for safety reasons
- Classes pinned through 8th place.
- High point awarded – Open and Youth
