### EQUINE HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:

- Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) is not required for New York origin horses. CVI is required for imported horses.
- Negative Equine Infectious Anemia (EIA) test is required for all horses 6 months of age or older. The horse must be accompanied by a valid negative EIA test record. The test must have been conducted during the current or previous calendar years for New York origin horses. For imported horses, the test must be conducted within 12 months of entry.
- The EIA test certificate must include a complete description of the horse.
- Current rabies vaccination is required for all horses 105 days of age or older.
- Papers **WILL** be checked.

- Entry fees and rules specific to disciplines are listed with each show.
- No one other than exhibitors may ride, school or train an equine entered in the show while on show grounds. Exceptions may be made if a request is directed to the show manager. Safety will always be of primary concern.
- All exhibitors must have their show numbers visibly displayed at all times when mounted or in the show ring.
- Protests are to be lodged with the Technical Delegate prior to the beginning of the next event or class. The Technical Delegate will then determine the necessity of approaching the judge through the Ring Steward.
- No parent, coach, visitor or exhibitor may approach, questions, or direct public comment to or about the judge. Violations will be handled on an individual basis by the Horse Superintendent and Show Committee.
- Good sportsmanship is a must!
- No dogs allowed on the grounds.
- No stabling available.
- No stallions permitted in youth classes or in Fun Show.
- Proper equestrian footwear must be worn.
- All exhibitors under the age of 18 and those entered in jumping classes must wear an ASTM-SEI approved helmet. (ASTM-1163/SEI or ASTM-F-1163-04a SEI).
- Youth riders are defined as a rider who is at least 8 years old and under 19 years old as of January 1, 2011.
- An approved helmet and equestrian footwear must be worn by youth at all times when mounted, riding in a vehicle being pulled by one or more equines and when youth are in the show ring.
- All classes pinned 1<sup>st</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> with the exception of lead-line and dressage in which participation rosettes will be received.
- Points towards champion and champion reserve are based on at least 6 riders in a class with 6 pts for 1<sup>st</sup> place, 5 for 2<sup>nd</sup>, etc. If less than 6 riders, points will be adjusted according to the number of riders. Ex: 4 riders – 1<sup>st</sup> place – 4 pts, 2<sup>nd</sup> place – 3 pts, etc.
